What to do if you are being questioned by the police:

According to the American Civil Liberties Union, if you are ever stopped by a police officer you are expected to provide your name, and identification. If you don't have any identification with you he can ask you your address and date of birth. Other than that, you don't have to answer any other questions. As they say on Cops, "You have the right to remain silent."

If you are in an accident it is best to follow these general guidelines:

1. Stop - Never leave the scene of an accident until the police arrive.
2. Call 911 to summon the police and an ambulance if necessary. Have the police prepare an accident report even if there is minimal damage to the vehicle.
3. Get names, addresses, telephone numbers and insurance information for all drivers involved in the accident.
4. Report the accident to your insurance agent, or have your attorney do it for you.
5. Don't try and settle your own case - this is a job for your attorney or your insurance agent.
6. Check your car insurance policy to determine if you have rental car coverage and/or medical payment coverage on the policy.
